





Saxon Hill Academy is a special school for pupils and students aged 2 to 19 years of age, who come from all over South Staffordshire. All of our pupils have physical disabilities and associated sensory, medical, learning and communication difficulties.

We have a range of specialist teaching areas and facilities that enables us to meet the individual needs of each child within a stimulating, but supportive environment. These include: -

- Sensory studio, Hydrotherapy pool, Rebound Therapy
- On site nursing and physiotherapy services
- Extensive school grounds with sensory garden, forest school and horticulture area
- Multi purpose hall
- School minibuses

We also have a 14 bed Sleepover care centre as part of our resources that support pupils and their families during the term time, developing self help and independence skills and supporting the school curriculum and life skills of our pupils. Students can stay overnight Monday – Thursday.

This post will play a vital role in the success of the school and in the provision of access to opportunities for our pupils and the successful applicants will need to demonstrate good interpersonal skills, commitment, sensitivity, reliability and flexibility.
