All teaching groups receive 4 one-hour lessons per week and students are put into sets according to ability. In KS3 students follow bespoke schemes of work and in KS4 students follow the Edexcel Linear specification. The faculty consists of a suite of 9 classrooms, all of which have interactive whiteboards and a breadth of resources.
