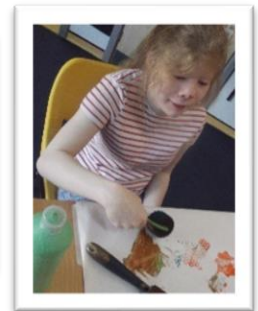

About us...

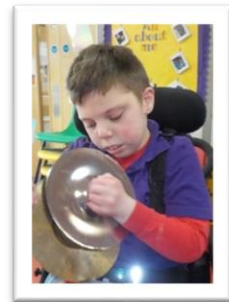
